The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with  
  
Main P.S. Case No. 22 of 2017 registered under Sections 406 and  
  
420 of the Indian Penal Code and section 7 of the Essential  
  
Commodities Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the  
  
petitioner submits that the matter relates to section 7 of the  
  
Essential Commodities Act. Petitioner is innocent and has falsely  
  
been made accused in this case due to oblique reason. Further  
  
submission is that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the  
  
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the



event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Gaya in connection with Main P.S. Case No. 22 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
