ORAL JUDGMENT

Inter alia contending that certain directions issued in
CWJC No 6022 of 2008 on 25.11.2011 in the matter of refund of
earnest money and security amount have not been complied with, the
application for initiating contempt has been filed and from the
supplementary show cause filed by the Opposite Parties on 28th of
March 2017, it transpires that a sum of Rs 5,14,600/-, after deduction
of certain amount, has been credited to the account of the petitioner.

2 That being so, now no further action is required to be
taken in the matter. Even though belatedly, the Opposite Parties have



complied the order and tendered apology for the delay, the same is accepted and in view of this, Opposite Parties are discharged from contempt proceedings.

3 In case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the compliance made, he may initiate proceedings afresh.

4 With the aforesaid liberty, this application is disposed of.
