7 16-05-2017 The petitioner and the opposite party no.2 both are present physically with their learned counsels. Both are ready to live together.

The petitioner is directed to go to his in-laws house to bring back the opposite party no.2 with her children within one week. In case the petitioner brings back the opposite party no.2 and her children then after surrender within four weeks the petitioner shall be released on provisional bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M-II, Chapra, District- Saran in connection with Marhowrah (Gaura O.P.) P.S. Case No.



145 of 2016, and the learned court below shall watch their conduct by calling them after three months and if their conducts remained good then the provisional bail granted shall be confirmed by the learned court below itself, failing which the bail granted to the petitioner will be deemed to be cancelled.
