The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with  
Complaint Case No. 247C of 2015 registered for the offences  
under sections 380/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

she has filed a case under Domestic Violence Act vide D.V. Case No. 8 of 2015. The present case is counter blast of the same. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Smt. Kiran Chaturvedi, Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Patna in connection with Complaint Case No. 247C of 2015 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
