Heard Mr. Abhay Kumar Singh learned senior counsel
for the petitioner and Mr. M. N. Parbat learned senior counsel for
Madhya Bihar Gramin Bank.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submitted that
this writ petition has been filed under wrong advice, as the statutory
appeal is provided under the act against the order of punishment.
Therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with
leave, so that the petitioner may present the appeal with a petition to
condone the delay and after disposal of appeal the petitioner may file
the writ petition.



Considering the facts the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to present the statutory appeal before the competent authority within one month and if such appeal is filed, the authority shall consider favourably to condone the delay on account of filing this writ petition on wrong advice.
