Keeping in view the order passed on 17.03.2017 and the submission made by the respondents to say that the petitioner has already been granted benefit of regularization but there being some dispute with regard to the date of gratuity, now it is not proper to initiate any action of contempt. In case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the manner in which his consideration has been made, it gives a fresh cause to the petitioner to ventilate the said grievance but the same cannot be a ground for initiating action for contempt against the respondents. Respondents are discharged from the proceedings and the



contempt application disposed of.
