It would appear from the report of the trial court that except
doctor and I.O. almost all prosecution witnesses have already been
examined and, therefore, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on
bail and, again, his prayer for bail in connection with Session trial no.
708/2014 arising out of Thakraha (Bhitaha) P.S. Case no. 41/2003
stands rejected.

and I.O. of Thakraha (Bhitaha) P.S. Case no. 41/2003 corresponding
to Session trial no. 708/2014 before Addl. Sessions Judge I, Bagaha,

receipt/production of a copy of this order, if they have not been
examined before the trial court as yet and after examination of doctor



and I.O, the concerned court must dispose of the above stated sessions trial within two months from the date of examination of last prosecution witness.
