Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 12
of 2017 instituted for the offence under Section-414/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the alleged
vehicle has been recovered from the garage of Md. Nasim. The
petitioner is said to be sitting on the Tata Safari vehicle in
suspicious condition and on seeing police party, he tried to escape
from there but he has been apprehended by the police.

Learned APP has submitted that the petitioner has



confessed his guilt before the police. The charge sheet has already been submitted in this case.

In such circumstances, prayer for bail is allowed.
