2 30-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

This is an application for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who is accused in Nawada Town P.S. Case No. 200 of 2017 for offence under Section 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 353, 188, 283, 337, 153A, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 27 of Arms Act and Section 3/4 of Explosive Substance Act.

From perusal of F.I.R. it appears large number of persons have made accused in this case. Similarly circumstance accused have been granted bail by this Hon'ble Court passed in Cr. Misc. No. 24018 of 2017 vide order dated 17.05.2017 and Cr. Misc. No. 24332 of 2017 vide order dated 22.05.201.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am inclined



to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada or his successor Court, in connection with Nawada Town P.S. Case No. 200 of 2017, subject to the condition that he will extend full co-operation in the case and will not, in any manner, influence the witnesses or the evidence.
