3 10-07-2017 In the mater of appointment to the post in question on contract basis when the petitioner and the private respondents received equal marks, weightage to the qualification acquired in the intermediate examination was given to the private respondent. The learned writ court has approved the aforesaid policy followed



for selecting the candidates when two candidates had identical marks. The approach adopted by the learned writ court is quite right and hence, we do not find any reason to make indulgence in the matter.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
