The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Sakara P.S.Case No.127 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 (1-B)a/26/35/25(1-AA) and 25 (1-AAA) of the Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner as per F.I.R. is that the police raided the place and from the possession of the other accused persons, one pistol and one cartridge have been recovered but from the possession of this petitioner only one cartridge has been recovered and now he is in custody for 3 ½ months.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. C.J.M.-cum-Sub Judge-XIII, Muzaffapur in connection with Sakara P.S.Case No.127 of 2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
