Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Sections 30 (A) & 38 (B) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 31.625 liters of foreign wine were recovered from the house of the petitioner. It is urged that the petitioner is in custody since 18.6.2017.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge – cum – 4th Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur in connection with Kotwali



(Tilkamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 341 of 2017.

If the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.

That apart, in view of the antecedents of the petitioner, he would be required to appear before the Superintendent of Police, Bhagalpur within fifteen days of his release with a copy of this order and every two weeks thereafter for the next six months. The conduct of the petitioner will be kept under watch in the aforesaid period by the Superintendent of Police concerned and if it is found wanting in any respect, a report shall be made to the court concerned by him to initiate a proceeding for cancellation of bail for reasons of misuse of bail. After reporting to the Superintendent of Police, a certificate will be filed by the petitioner before the court concerned which should be granted by the Superintendent of Police upon his appearance.
