Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with Bodh
Gaya (Cherki) P.S.Case No. 500 of 2016 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 272, 273, 34 of the Indian
Penal Code and 30(A) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation as per FIR is of recovery of 52 litres of
country made liquor.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
nothing has been recovered from his possession and he is in
custody for more than two months having clean antecedent.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and considering the aforesaid
facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, named above, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees
twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to



the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Gaya (Cherki) P.S.Case No. 500 of 2016, subject to the conditions that :-

(i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.

(ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.

(iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
