2 19-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Sections 30 (a)/56 (D) of Bihar Excise Amendment Act.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 240 bottles (180 ml each) and 4310 bottles (180 ml each) of foreign liquor were recovered from the dicky of the two vehicles. The name of the petitioner has come on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Prafull Singh. It is urged that the petitioner is in custody since 26.05.2017. It is claimed that his antecedent is clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of



Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Piro (Hasan Bazar) P.S. Case No. 124/2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
