ORAL ORDER

2 22-08-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

NDPS Case No. 07 of 2017, registered for offences punishable

under Section 20(B) of NDPS Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of recovery of 7.332
kg of ganja.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he
has falsely been implicated in this case and the seizure list was
not prepared as per the mandatory provisions. It has also been
submitted that vehicle from alleged recovery was made was hired
by other co-accused of this case and only petitioner has been made
main accused showing recovery from him. Further he has been in
judicial custody since 07.04.2017 and has no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail



and submitted that in this case there is recovery of Ganja, which is more than the small quantity.

Having heard both sides, in view of the facts and circumstances and quantity of ganja recovered in this case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail, his application for regular bail is accordingly rejected.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and try to conclude it within a period of nine months and if the trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail in the court below itself.
