2 20-09-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as
well as the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner wants to renew his prayer for bail which was earlier rejected by order dated 16.09.2016 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 33820 of 2016 which was disposed of with Cr. Misc. No. 31112 of 2016, on the ground that the petitioner is suffering in custody since 29.12.2015 and only on the basis of the criminal antecedent the petitioner has been implicated in this case, the confessional statement of Anchal Jha made before the police has got no evidentiary value in the eye of law, without any legal and cogent material the petitioner has been charge sheeted resulting he is suffering in custody, other co-accused have been allowed bail by different co-ordinate Benches of this Court.



The learned A.P.P. opposes prayer for bail of the petitioner by submitting that during investigation sufficient materials have been collected which goes to suggest involvement of the petitioner in the crime.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, finding no good ground for reconsideration of prayer for bail, again prayer for bail of the petitioner stands rejected in connection with S. Tr. No. 146 of 2016 arising out of Baheri P.S. Case No. 270 of 2015 pending in the court of Sessions Judge, Darbhanga.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite and conclude the trial after keeping the same on the priority basis preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, failing which the petitioner, if at no fault, may be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
