2 09-11-2017 I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for
offences punishable under sections 272 and 273 of the Indian
Penal Code and section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 11 litres 250 Ml.
of foreign liquor was recovered from possession of the
petitioners. Petitioners claim that they are having clean
antecedents and are in custody since 28.8.2017.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the
case, the above named petitioners are directed to be released



on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 447 of 2017.

If the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
