learned counsel for the opposite parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner Om Prakash
Singh and learned counsel for the opposite party No. 2 Anupam
Kumari, the informant of Bypass P.S. Case No. 80 of 2011,
submit that they have settled their disputes and are willing to file
a compromise petition. The offences wherein cognizance has
been taken are under Sections 420,467 and 468 of the Indian
Penal Code.

If the parties have settled their disputes and are
going to file compromise petition, there is no reason that the



learned court below would prolong with the trial. Hence, the court below shall dispose of the case within two months from the date of filing of the compromise petition without giving unnecessary adjournments and the parties shall fully co-operate in early conclusion of the trial.

With the aforesaid observations, the application stands disposed of.
