Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

It has been submitted by the petitioner that he is a
licence holder of P.D.S. shop. Time to time, her licence was
renewed, but in the year 2003 the agreement was terminated till
further order. It has further been submitted that her licence was
renewed in the year 2011 and thereafter the authority has refused to
renew the same. The petitioner has filed a representation before the
Sub-Divisional Officer, Sadar Darbhanga, bringing all the facts to
