3 18-03-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Asarganj P. S. Case No. 60 of 2016 instituted under Sections
7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

The allegation, in brief, is that six bags of rice of
Mid-Day-Meal were recovered in front of the house of the
petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this
petitioner runs a small rice mill and the said rice was supplied by
the Principal of the concerned school for re-polishing and the
Principal has been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this
Court vide order dated 03.03.2017 in Cr. Misc. No. 5228 of 2017
and this petitioner has no any criminal antecedent.



Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, namely, Laxman Sah @ Lakshaman Saw in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Akhilesh Pandey, S.D.J.M., Munger in connection with Asarganj P.S.Case No. 60 of 2016; subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
