2 27-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 385/387 of the Indian Penal Code.

The F.I.R. is against unknown and only material against the petitioner is confessional statement of the co-accused before the police.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like



amount each to the satisfaction of Mr. Pramod Kumar Pandey, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gaya/Successor Court in connection with Mufassil Police Station Case No.226 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. With further condition that petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the Court-below shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail-bonds of the petitioner in this case.
