7 30-10-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Singhia P.S. Case No. 88 of 2017 registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that there is case and counter case between the parties. Both sides sustained injuries. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two

Chief Judicial Magistrate V, Rosera, Samastipur in connection
with Singhia P.S. Case No. 88 of 2017 subject to the conditions
laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
