ORAL ORDER

5 19-05-2017 Keeping in view the show cause filed by the respondents today indicating the payment of Rs.9,02,486/- to the petitioner through cheque No.910201 drawn on the State Bank of India Main Branch, Gaya and payment to the petitioner on 21.02.2017, as is evident from the receipt endorsed by the petitioner in Annexure-D and copy of the cheque along with the show cause, no further action is required to be taken in the matter.
