The challenge in the present writ application is to

the order dated 25.01.2016 passed by the District Teachers

Employment Appellate Authority, Buxar in Appeal No. 04 of 2013.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State

submitted that the order is appealable before the State Teachers



Employment Appellate Authority, which has now become functional.

In view of the fact that the matter involves issues of fact and the Appellate Authority is functional, the Court is not inclined to go into the matter, at this stage.
