2 22-03-2017 The petitioner who is an Advocate has brought to the notice of this Court certain issues regarding illegalities in the matter of an appointment and promotion of the teachers in the Bhagalpur University, Bhagalpur.



The Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **(Bholanath Mukherjee & Ors. Vs Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College & Ors.)**, reported in **2011(5) SCC 464** and the Delhi High Court in the case of **W.P.(C) 1698 / 2017 (Forum of SC and ST Legislators and Parliamentarians Vs. Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. & Anr.)**, decided on 27.02.2017 has laid down the principle that in issues pertaining to service matter a Public Interest Litigation is not maintainable.

In view of the aforesaid, we are not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application stands disposed of.
