ORAL ORDER

3 12-04-2017 The petitioner is in custody since 03.03.2017 in connection with Supaul P.S. Case No. 57 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 447, 341, 323, 324, 307, 354, 504/34 of Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner that he along with others assaulted the doctor and other staffs of hospital.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that as a matter of fact a relative of the petitioner died in the alleged hospital and persons aggrieved were raising hulla but has not assaulted any one and as such no case under above mentioned Section of Indian Penal Code is made out against the petitioner.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, nature of offence and the period of



custody, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Supaul, in connection with Supaul P.S. Case No. 57 of 2017, subject to following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
