ORAL ORDER

2 12-04-2017 This is an application for grant of bail for offences
punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected
vide order dated 16.2.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. no. 5803 of 2017
with liberty to the petitioner to renew his prayer for bail after
framing of charge.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner from
Annexure-3 series that thereafter petitioner has moved before the
learned court below but his prayer was rejected on the ground that
no fresh ground has come in favour of the petitioner.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the observation
made earlier, let above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty-five thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J.-I, Sitamarhi, in connection with Bela P.S. Case no. 62 of 2016 with the following conditions:-

- (i) Both the bailors of the petitioner shall be local persons having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.

This application stands disposed of.
