Learned Single Judge was correct in dismissing the Writ Application vide his order dated 25.11.2014 for the reason that the appellant is an employee of an affiliated college and, therefore, no writ will lie with regard to the grievance relating to his status or payment of salaries, etc. since the management is in the hands of a



private Managing Committee.

Dismissal of the appeal, however, may not come in the way if the appellant wants to move a Civil Court or negotiate a deal with the Managing Committee.

Appeal is dismissed.
