3 14-12-2017 Reasons given for delay of 5 years and 165 days in
preferring the appeal are neither convincing nor cogent on
which such extraordinary delay ought to be condoned.

We have also glanced through the impugned order passed
by the learned Single Judge, who refused to interfere with the
order of punishment of discharge because of preponderance of
materials and evidence, which had come during the course of



inquiry with finding of guilt. Therefore, we are not inclined to condone the delay of 5 years and 165 days in preferring the appeal.

The condonation application is dismissed. As a consequence thereof, even the appeal stands dismissed.
