3 05-06-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mehandia P.S.Case No. 103/2016 for the offences under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 307, 379, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

From perusal of FIR it appears that the occurrence took place on account of land dispute between the parties. Although the petitioners have been named in the FIR, save and except petitioner no.1, there is no specific allegation against petitioner no. 2. The allegation against petitioner no.1 is that he snatched Rs. 500/- from the informant. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioners have clean antecedent.



Having regard to the fact that there is land dispute between the parties and no specific over act of assault has been alleged against the petitioners, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal in connection with Mehandia P.S.Case No.103 of 2016,subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C.
