2 21-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 7 of the
Essential Commodities Act, 1955.

From the house of this petitioner rice and wheat were
recovered.

Submission of the petitioner is that the petitioner is a
miller and during investigation it revealed that no anomaly or
irregularity was found.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner,
above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the
Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt



of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Jamui/Successor Court in connection with Jamui Police Station Case No.3 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. With further condition that petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the Court-below shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail-bonds of the petitioner in this case.
