3 30-06-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Shahpur P.S. Case No. 78 of 2016, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, Usha Devi the daughter of the informant was married with the petitioner, out of wedlock there are two sons and two daughters, one of the daughter has attained the age of marriage, to purchase harvester the petitioner and other demanded money from Usha Devi and due to refusal she was killed by the petitioner and others after strangulating her.

Submission is of false implication and that the money was deposited for the marriage of daughter in joint account, the



allegation of pressurizing the deceased is totally false, the deceased died due to illness and her dead body was cremated in presence of the informant but informant later on lodged this false case and, as such, the petitioner deserves sympathetic consideration.

The learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer of pre-arrest bail by submitting that the petitioner is the husband and he was pressurizing for money and killed her and, as such, the petitioner does not deserves bail.

In the facts and circumstances as stated above, considering the allegation attributed against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant privilege of pre-arrest bail to him and accordingly his such prayer stands rejected in connection with Shahpur P.S. Case No. 78 of 2016, pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.-14th, Bhojpur.
