2 03-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 302/498A/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Petitioner is husband of the victim lady.
Allegation is that the victim was done to death for non-fulfilment
of dowry demand.

Submission is that the death occurred after ten
years of marriage and there is no eyewitness of the occurrence.
Vide Annexure-2 the informant had given in writing to the learned
Court-below that due to anger he has lodged this case without
proper verification of the matter.



Considering the facts and circumstances, let petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Muzaffarpur/Successor Court, in connection with Kathaiya P.S. Case No.12 of 2013, with condition that petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the Court-below shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail-bonds of the petitioner in this case.
