APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Singheshwar P.S. Case
No. 118 of 2016 registered under Section 392 of the Indian Penal
Code.

As per prosecution case, three motorcycle borne
criminals are said to have looted the motorcycle, mobile phone
and money of the informant by dashing the motorcycle of the
informant on the way.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. Nothing incriminating
article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession



of the petitioner. His name was surfaced in the case on the basis of the confessional statement of the co-accused Kanhaiya Kumar Yadav after lapse of five months of the occurrence. The petitioner has been languishing in custody since 23.09.2016.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura in connection with Singheshwar P.S. Case No. 118 of 2016.
