ORAL ORDER

- 2 14-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
- The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Baghaila P.S.
- Case No. 28 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections 341,
323, 324, 307, 452, 379, 354(A), 427, 504, 506/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.
- It has been submitted that there is case and counter
case. There is specific allegation against Rajgrihi Singh of
assaulting the informant and his wife.
- There is general and omnibus allegation against this
petitioner and other accused persons of assaulting the son of the
informant Akhilesh Kumar. with rod, *lathi*, *danda* etc. on his head.
- The injury report of Akhilesh Kumar has been
enclosed as Annexure-1 wherein the doctor has found simple



injury on his person.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioner, named above, within six weeks from today, in connection with Baghaila P.S. Case No. 28 of 2017, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtas (Sasaram), subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioner and (3) if petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
