4 24-08-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Singhia P.S. Case No. 84 of 2017, registered for offences
punishable under Sections 30(a), 38(i) (ii) and 41(i) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 180 ML of foreign liquor
from the bolero vehicle of the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he
has falsely been implicated in this case and has no criminal
antecedent and has been in judicial custody since 25.05.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and
circumstances of the case, nature of allegation and also that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has remained in custody



for three months, as such, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge – 6th, - Cum- Special Judge, Samastipur, in connection with Singhia P.S. Case No. 84 of 2017.

It is made clear that if the petitioner again found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
