Inter alia contending that several doctors are posted in Nalanda district and they are continuing to work for more than 10 years, accordingly, challenging the act of the State Government in posting the doctors for a long period, this writ petition has been filed.

2 Taking notice of these facts, it is not appropriate for this Court to go into all these aspects of the matter which is nothing but an administrative action for transfer and posting of employees. A Writ Court, in a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution, is not



required to go into these questions. Petitioner may move the administrative authorities of the State Government who will look into the grievance of the petitioner.

3 With the aforesaid observations/directions, this writ petition is disposed of.
