The grievance of the petitioner pertains to improper implementation of a non-statutory guidelines with regard to various constructions work undertaken by the Nagar Panchayat. The guidelines, in question, breach of which is complained of in the writ petition, is not a statutory guidelines and, therefore, for enforcing such a non-statutory guidelines and for its breach, we are not inclined to interfere in the matter. Petitioner may bring these facts to the notice of the competent authority, in-charge for implementation of the scheme and it would be for the competent authority to look into the matter.



With the aforesaid observation, finding no case for issuing any mandamus, the writ petition is dismissed.
