2 19-08-2017 Heard Sri Bimlesh Kumar Pandey, learned counsel
for the petitioner and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, who is in custody since
08.07.2017 in Dhanaha P.S. Case No.119/17 registered for the
offence under Section 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act, 2017, has prayed for grant of bail.

It was submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that it is a peculiar case, in which though an Alto
vehicle was intercepted by the police and the police allowed the
main accused persons to flee away and the petitioner was shown to
be apprehended as if he was driving the said vehicle. He submits
that the petitioner was not at all aware of carrying liquor, which
was carried by other persons, who were allowed to go escort free.
He submits that the petitioner is having clean antecedent, which



has been stated in paragraph-3 of the petition.

Considering the nature of accusation, clean antecedent as well as period of custody, let the petitioner, namely, Ram Kripal Yadav be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Dhanaha P.S. Case No.119/17
