ORAL ORDER

2 25-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offences under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that as per allegation, 210 bottles
each containing 300 ml, i.e., total 63 litres of Nepali Soufi wine
were allegedly recovered from the sack which was being carried
on head by the petitioner. Petitioner claims that he is having
clean antecedent and is in custody since 10.05.2017.

Considering the facts and the circumstances of the
case, the petitioner, above named is directed to be released on



bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional District & Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Ghorasahan (Jitna) P.S. Case No. 222 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
