3 09-10-2017 Heard learned counsel for the appellants.

This appeal has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail in connection with Arwal SC/ST P.S.Case No. 14 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3(i)(c)(s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and for setting aside the impugned order dated 21.7.2017 passed by Additional Sessions Judge-I, Jehanabad.

Allegation against the appellants is of abusing the informant by taking her caste name and also of assaulting her and others.



Submission of learned counsel for the appellants is that no specific allegation has been attributed against them and there is case and counter case between the parties and they have falsely been implicated in this case.

Heard learned Special P.P. also, who has opposed the prayer for pre-arrest bail on the ground of maintainability.

Having heard both sides and in view of allegation, this appeal is not maintainable, rather appellants to surrender within a period of six weeks and pray for regular bail, which shall be considered on its own merit, without being prejudiced by this order, preferably on the same day.

With the above observation, this appeal is disposed of.
