5 18-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 326, 302, 447 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Petitioner is the co-villager of the informant. He is not named in the FIR, though others are named in the FIR.

The report of the learned court below reveals that investigation against the petitioner is still pending.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria/successor Court in connection with Narpatganj Police Station Case No. 166 of 2001, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
