In this Public Interest petition, the petitioner has filed this writ petition and seeks a mandamus to the Government to file an appeal against the decision of Munsif, Jagdishpur, Bhojpur in a decree granted to the respondent nos. 4 and 5, in a Title Suit No. 74 of 2007 as a decree has been passed in their favour.

When this court put a question to the petitioner as to how mandamus can be issued to the State Government directing them to file an appeal under Section 96 of the Code of Civil Procedure and under what law, the public interest litigation can be filed for this,
