5 08-11-2017 Heard Sri Dhananjay Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel, who has appeared on behalf of North Frontier Railway.

The present petition has been filed with a prayer to restore Miscellaneous Appeal No. 44 of 2013 , which stood dismissed due to non- compliance of peremptory order dated 28.07.2014. The reason for non- compliance of peremptory order has appropriately been explained in the petition.

Accordingly, the restoration petition is allowed and Miscellaneous Appeal No. 44 of 2013 is directed to be restored to its original file with indication that if the order dated 28.07.2014 passed in Miscellaneous Appeal No. 44 of 2013 is not complied by 24th November, 2017, the Miscellaneous
