The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated  
23.12.2013 bearing Memo No. 2239 dated 31.12.2013 of the  
District Programme Officer, West Champaran, whereby the  
application of the petitioner has been rejected. The petitioner  
feeling aggrieved has moved in appeal before the appellate  
authority i.e. District Magistrate, West Champaran at Bettiah  
giving rise to R.M.Case No. 58/2015-16 but which remains
