2 17-10-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case instituted under
Sections 272, 273 of Indian Penal Code and Section 30(A) of
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that 29 litres of country made liquor is said
to have been recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that
the petitioners are in custody since 06.08.2017. The petitioners
have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. It is alleged



that 29 litres of country made wine is said to have been recovered.

There is no compliance of section 100 of the Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the state, it has been submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge (Excise), East Champaran at Motihari, in connection with Excise Case No.1045 of 2017, arising out of Ramgadhwa P.S. Case No.140 of 2016.
