ORAL ORDER

3 12-12-2017 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Habibpur Police Station Case No. 54 of 2016, disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 406, 420, 467, 471, 385 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, there is land dispute between the parties and on account of that this petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The dispute is purely civil in nature and for that no criminal liability be imposed on the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-XII, Bhagalpur, in connection with Habibpur Police Station Case No. 54 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
