The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Pipra P.S. Case No. 274 of 2015, registered for the offences

In the facts and circumstances as stated above, the petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 274 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down in section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
