2 20-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 3761 of 2016, registered under Section
498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of torturing the complainant-
opposite party no. 2 by her husband and in-laws due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry and also to remove from her
matrimonial house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant-opposite party
no. 2 and she has falsely been implicated in this case with ulterior
motive.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Gopalganj, in connection with Complaint Case No. 3761 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
