A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 36 litres foreign liquor was recovered from the possession of the accused persons including the petitioner. Petitioner claims that he is having clean antecedent and is in custody since 13.09.2017.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of the 4th Addl. Sessions Judge, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Barahara P.S. Case No. 261 of 2017.

Further, if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in similar nature of case then the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.
